When Wattle & Daub come to the stage, their genuine affection and humor are infectious. It's probably why, when they first started making music together in 2013, audiences thought they were married. Now that they are, singer/songwriters Tim and Susan Mocarski continue to get listeners involved in their songs. Whether it's Susan rolling her eyes at one of Tim's awkward chord changes or their knowing glances at each other during a love song, their goal is get their listeners involved in the music, and yes, that often means a hearty invitation to sing along with them.

Their name comes from a centuries old construction method. In describing how they decided on the name during a road trip, they wrote: "We saw this country and its beauty. We thought of how immigrants from all over the world, of different races and different beliefs have come to help build this nation, to weave it together, to strengthen it. We thought of how our own relationship is growing and weaving together. We believe in the country and in each other. We are making music. We are building our lives. We want the nation to grow. We think the process is simple. All we need is some Wattle & Daub."

Wattle & Daub is an acoustic duo performing a mixture of original and covers of contemporary and traditional folk/Americana with an occasional twist on popular standards.

Currently based in Grayslake, IL, they have performed extensively throughout SE Wisconsin and Northern Illinois. Among their appearances are The Coffeehouse at Chestnut and Pine. Roots Café, Bonk! Performance Series, Fox Valley Folk Festival, Lake County Folk Club, Two Way Street Coffeehouse, Smith Brothers Coffeehouse, Art\*Bar, and Hog Wild in the Woods.

Their first album, "Struggles and Love," was released in 2017. In 2017 and 2018 they embarked on multi-state tours throughout the Northeast and doing so again mid summer, 2019.
